

DIMICELI WILL SEEK CONGRESSIONAL POST

Leonard DiMiceli, San Pedro attorney and civic leader, has been endorsed as the official Republican candidate for Congress from the 17th District, to oppose Rep. Cecil R. King, in next year's elections.

Meeting Monday night, the Candidate and Fact Finding Committee of the 17th District after endorsing DiMiceli dedicated itself to a vigorous campaign to nominate and elect the candidate.

Robert H. Finch, chairman of the Republican Central Committee of Los Angeles County, and a member of the endorsing committee, said that "DiMiceli will have the full support of the Republican organization and the United Republican Finance in the conduct of his campaign."

The committee of 195 leading Republicans is made up of representatives of the Republican County Central Committee, the Republican State Central Committee and all authorized volunteer Republican organizations of the district. The meeting was held at El Camino College.

Responding to the endorsement, DiMiceli pledged that he will "strive with all I have to make this campaign successful, for the love of the nation you believe in, and for the children to come, I shall campaign for American unity and for the perpetuation of Republican principals and ideals. I pledge you that I will always keep before me one yard-stick: If it is right, I will stand for it, with all my energy, come what may, even to the loss of friends. If it is wrong, I shall oppose it with equal vigor."

Charles Soderstrom Jr., chairman of the Republican Central Committee for the 17th and chairman of the Candidate and Fact Finding Committee, drew the support of the group behind DiMiceli's candidacy.

DiMiceli has been a resident of San Pedro since 1942. He was born in Louisiana on Oct. 30, 1905, received his LL.B. degree at the University of Idaho in 1934, and was admitted to the California bar in 1938. He was married in July, 1935, to M. Katherine McCaw, of Aberdeen, Wash. They have two daughters, Anne Marie, 15, and Mary Elizabeth, 8. He is a member of Grandview Methodist Church, San Pedro.

The candidate is past president of the 68th District Republican Assembly; president of the 17th Congressional District Republican Assembly; chairman of the Republican Coordinating Council of the 68th District; member of the Los

Angeles County Republican Speakers Bureau; was a delegate in 1952 to the Republican National Convention; is a member of the Republican Central

Committee of Los Angeles County and an associate member of the Republican State Central Committee.

He is a member of the Ephebian Society; Phi Alpha Delta legal honorary society; was general chairman of the Republican Presidential Campaign Committee for the Los

Angeles Harbor Area in 1952; general chairman, Eisenhower Volunteers, Los Angeles Harbor Area, 1952; General Chairman, Democrats for Eisenhower Campaign Committee, Los Angeles Harbor Area, 1952; past president San Pedro Lions Club; member of the Masons and Elks in San Pedro; past vice president, Italo-American Voters' League; past vice president, Federated Italo-American of San Pedro; past president, Los Angeles Conference on Immigration and Citizen-

ship; past vice president, Harbor Bar Assn.; past vice president, San Pedro Boys Club; member of California Bar Assn.; Los Angeles Bar Assn.; American Bar Assn.; and National Assn. of Immigration and Nationality Lawyers.
