TORRANCE HERALD-569 ORDINANCE NO. 917 AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TORRANCE, CALIFORNIA, AMENDING SECTION 15.33 TO "THE CODE OF THE CITY OF TORRANCE, 1954" BY REPEALING THE MAKING, EXHIBITION, SALE, OR POSSESSION, ETC., OF UNLAWFUL, INDECENT, OR OBSCENE WRITINGS, PHOTOGRAPHS, RECORDINGS, AND OTHER ARTICLES. The City Council of the City of Torrance does ordain as follows: SECTION 1. That Section 15.33 is hereby added to the Code of the City of Torrance, 1954, and shall read in its entirety as follows: SECTION 15.33. Lewd, indecent, or obscene literature, etc. (a) No person shall write, compose, stereotype, print, publish, exhibit, sell or have in his possession or under his control any lewd, indecent, or obscene bill, poster, magazine, writing, book, pamphlet, engraving, photograph, motion picture film, cast, statue, or image, photograph record, electrical transcription, wire recording, or other device for the recording of sight or sound.

(b) No person shall willfully or remain present at any place where lewd, indecent, or obscene motion picture film, photograph record, electrical transcription, wire recording or other device for the recording of sight or sound is being played or can be readily referred to in suspension (a) and (b) of this section 15.33 by a policeman or other law enforcement officer for the purpose of the enforcement of this ordinance. Any person violating any provision of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction thereof, shall be subject to a fine not exceeding Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), or six (6) months in the County Jail of Los Angeles County, or both such fine and imprisonment, in the discretion of the Court. SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect thirty days after the date of its adoption and prior to the expiration of fifteen days from the passage thereof shall be published at least once in the Torrance Herald, a semi-weekly newspaper of general circulation, published and circulated in the City of Torrance.
