Delinquency Control Institute Graduates Anniversary Class

Rounding out its 11th year of operation, University of Southern California's Delinquency Control Institute has just graduated its 25th class of police juvenile officers who are returning to their home bases throughout the nation with special post graduate training in the handling of juvenile offenders.

Because of the concern of a group of big businessmen in the problems of juvenile delinquency, police and juvenile officers from all over the world are now receiving this training on a scholarship basis. Supported by contributions from Farmers Insurance Group, Safety Foundation and the Hollywood Turf Club Association Charities, the Institute since its inception in 1946 has graduated 404 officers from the United States and 11 other nations.

In addressing the graduating class, Thomas E. Leavey, president of Farmers Insurance Group, commented, "As an insurance company, we feel that we should contribute something to the civic welfare and

benefit of the community and we know of no better way to aid the future of our country and the world than by combatting juvenile delinquency."

Institute Director Dan G. Pursuit said that this year's class includes representatives from Missouri, Utah, Oregon, Pennsylvania, Wisconsin, Texas, Tennessee, Iowa, Florida, Washington, and California.

Students Screened
Screened from a large group of applicants by a special committee at the University, the students selected undergo an intensive 12-week study course in social treatment of delinquency, police techniques, prevention, legal aspects and speaking.

The 25 graduating classes to date have included students from Alaska, Costa Rica, England, Finland, Formosa, Germany, India, Iran, Japan, Korea, Norway, and Puerto Rico. Of the graduates, five have become chiefs of police, and all have been credited with bettering delinquency control and understanding in their own communities.

Leo M. Harvey Outlines Method Of Keeping American Leadership

One of the nation's leading technologists predicted in Memphis recently that close cooperation between government and industry research experts will enable the United States to maintain its proper place in the world's missile race and will develop public confidence in America's ability to move ahead of other nations.

Leo M. Harvey, president of Harvey Aluminum, Inc., told a group of 250 defense, government, business and industrial leaders "we know fundamentally the genius that dwells in our research and development labs, in our management people, and on our production lines is one of the strongest sinews in our national make-up."

Takes Over Plant
Harvey spoke at a welcoming dinner for his company given by the Tennessee Agricultural and Industrial Development Commission at the Chickasaw Country Club in Memphis. The Harvey firm became contractor-operator of the U.S. Army's Milan, Tenn., Arsenal on Oct. 15. It was operated previously by the Proctor and Gamble Defense Corp. but the firm relinquished its operation when its president, Neil H. McElroy, was appointed by President Eisenhower as Secretary of Defense succeeding Charles E. Wilson.

Governor Speaks
The welcoming address was given by Gov. Frank Clement of Tennessee. Other guests included U.S. Senators Albert Gore (D., Tenn.) James E. Murray (D., Mont.), Brig. Gen. C. J. Hauck, Jr., Deputy Assistant Secretary of Defense, Brig. Gen. Joseph M. Colby, Commanding General, Ordnance

Ammunition Command, and Col. Charles C. Latham, Jr., commanding officer, Milan Arsenal.

"We have been shaken up by recent demonstrations in the skies overhead," Harvey declared, "and we have become apprehensive, but this state of mind will not last."

"Government and Industry, cooperating to launch and develop new concepts, whether in the science of mathematics, or in conquering the problems of re-entry will help lead the way out of our current state of mind," he added.

The government-owned Milan Arsenal is located 90 miles northeast of Memphis. Its facilities include an ammunition loading plant and a field service storage depot.

Receives Citation
Gov. Clement, on behalf of the National American Legion, presented the Harvey firm with a citation for its program of hiring handicapped veterans.

Harvey Aluminum is the largest fabricator of wrought mill aluminum products under one roof in the world. It was recently named by the Atomic Energy Commission to test zirconium—the metal that made possible the atomic-powered submarine, Nautilus. The company was the first successful extruder of titanium in the world and now owns one of the two fully integrated titanium facilities in the U.S. Harvey research teams are presently working on metals and compounds for use in missiles.
