### Sewer Trunk Plans Given Council Okay

General approval of a plan to install a main sewer trunk to serve the area north of Torrance Blvd. and west of Madrona was granted by the city council this week. City Manager George Stevens was instructed to obtain more detailed plans for the project. In a proposal submitted by John Patrick, assistant to the city engineer, a 10-inch and 15-inch line would be installed from Maple Ave. west along the north side of the civic center, the north-to Garnet at Madrona, and west on Garnet to the west side of Hawthorne. Cost of the project would be about \$67,592, Patrick reported. A connection fee would be established in the area and the cost of project repaid by the property owners using the lines.


