Miss Walker says, "but I had no idea that the Row would attract so much publicity."

Miss Walker chose Raphael's Madonna as the first picture to be reproduced. She chose it because it represented to her the idea of Christmas and the reason for the celebration of the birth of Christ. This famous picture, one of many Madonnas by the great artist, is known as the "Cowper Madonna" for the original belongs to the Cowper collection.

AN EL Greco, "The Virgin with Santa Inez and Santa Tecla," was the choice in 1950. The original of the well-known El Greco hangs in the National Gallery in Washington, D. C. In 1951 a Madonna which

hangs in Melbourne, Australia's National Gallery, "The Ince Hall Madonna," by the great Dutch painter, Jan Van Eyck, was reproduced and added to the collection.

"The Virgin and St. John," painted by Botticelli for the Medici's Florentine school, was the next which the art class copied in 1952.

THE ORIGINAL of the 1953 reproduction is in Venice, Italy. From the pictures in the Acadmia of that city, Miss Walker chose "Virgin and Child" by Gian Plazetta after seeing the original.

"I knew I'd someday reproduce this beautiful picture," Miss Walker says. She did—

with the help of her art class. There are now five pictures. All measured 6 by 8 feet and Christmas will find all of them on standards fronting the college.

A new technique was used the following year. From a twelfth century Psalter, a book devoted to Psalms, the "Mosaic Madonna and Child" was done.

LIKE THE five oils which had preceded it, the mosaic was framed in gold. This was smaller, however. The mosaic's dimensions were 5 x 7.

Another oil painting was copied in 1955, "Rest on the Flight to Egypt" by Lorenzo Lollo. By the time this had been added, the row had gained wide recognition, but Miss

Walker wanted to add still more beauty.

THE NEXT year, stained glass and an ancient method of firing gold was used to produce a replica of the "Madonna of Chartres," valued at \$7000. The priceless window, in the original, still sheds jeweled light into the Chartres Cathedral in France. The first window is so old that its origin is lost in antiquity.

Last year Andrea del Soria's "Madonna of the Harpies" from the Uffizi gallery of Florence was painted and added. There were now nine Madonnas in the group, seven oils, one mosaic and one stained glass window.

**HEALTH OFFICER WARNS OF HOLIDAY HAZARDS**

Although enough of the original Christmas spirit remains to make Christmas one of the most joyous of holidays, crowds, and noise, hurry, irritation, and traffic congestion all contribute to make the season one of the most hazardous of the year as well.

Gradual changes have been taking place in the Christmas holiday season since the early part of the 19th century. Formerly a religious festivity celebrated throughout the Christian world on the birthday of Christ, with the passing of the years Christmas has become an increasingly social occasion.

USE OF THE evergreen tree at Christmas time is a custom that originated in Germany. It has spread to many parts of the world during the last century and a half, and has been wholeheartedly accepted in this country. So much a part of the festivity have the trees become, as a matter of fact, that Christmas just wouldn't be the same without them. As recently as 1926, it is recorded, a giant redwood in the General Grant National Park was dedicated as the "Nation's Christmas Tree."

Outside of traffic accidents, perhaps the most publicized yuletide hazard is the Christmas tree itself, which has become one of the symbols of Christmas to a great number of people. However, the Christmas tree is but one of the many hazards peculiar to this holiday season.

IT MAY SOMETIMES seem redundant to repeat that extra safety precautions must be observed during this holiday period as certain seasonal hazards make their appearance. Nevertheless, statistics of accidents and deaths due to Christmas hazards indicate that safety warnings cannot be too often repeated.

A few precautions particularly applicable to the Christmas season are herewith listed:

Be sure that toys are not made of paper, cotton, or plastics that are inflammable.
