The Spartan JV's did little better and were downed by the Centennial Sentinels, 28 to 16, for their first loss of the season.


Dave Birmingham lost to Hard of Inglewood in the heavy division in the battle of the meet while Dennis Pointon won over Sing in the 178-pound class.
