During the exercise, combat-ready troops from the infantry were airlifted from Korea to Okinawa in a demonstration of the Army's ability to send a fighting force to any potential trouble spot in the Far East.

Bushnell, a rifleman in the infantry's Company D in Korea, entered the Army in January, 1958, and arrived for duty in Korea last December. He received basic training at Fort Ord, Calif.
