Jack Moritz, who has been an account executive for one of the Southland's largest travel agencies for the past two years, has opened the Mercury Travel Service at 1309 Post Ave. (across from Bank of America), and is ready to provide travel arrangements for groups or individuals by any means of transportation available to all parts of the world.

Joining him in the office is Mrs. Ruth Loughery of Lomita, known to many Torrance area residents. She, also, has had wide experience in the travel field.

Moritz plans an active role in the community, and has joined the Chamber of Commerce as a starter, he says.

"TORRANCE has grown so, we thought it was ready for a first class travel bureau," Moritz said.

He pointed out that traveling rates are now so favorable, and the family plans available through airlines for off-peak travel make it possible for many Americans to visit abroad economically.

Shawger said the board of directors nominated Mill for the award on recommendation of the 1957 nominee, Robert I. Plomert Jr. of General Petroleum.


