Sea-Aire Golf Tourney Ends; New Champs

Two new young champions were crowned Wednesday as the Torrance Recreation Department's Teenage Spring Golf Tournament at Sea-Aire course ended with Don Clouch and Pat Drury shelving their trophies by beating out the fields in 13-years and over, and the under 12 brackets, respectively.

Second and third place in the upper division went to Mike Reis (168) and Mike Miller (174), while Bill Gunn (178) and Bob Bardeen (186) took second and third in the lower age bracket.

Allen Pell, boys director for the recreation department, praised the young golfers for their fine showing in the tournament and pointed out that the course, located at the end of Reynolds Dr., was open to the public daily except Mondays from 8 a.m. until dusk.
