Located in the central manufacturing district of Torrance, the new headquarters features one of the most modern warehouses in the nation, comprising 875,000 cubic feet of storage space and 10,000 square

feet of office space. Vice-president, John H. Zeigler, informed Chamber of Commerce officials yesterday that a 60-foot truck scale will be available to the general trucking industry and a three-car railroad spur will be on hand for carload shipments. A complete gasoline station with a 10,000 gallon capacity storage tank and a maintenance shop for overhaul and repair of all Columbia equipment are other unique features included in the facility.

Each member is requested to bring a light-weight boxed or packaged food item to be sent to the missionary in Ghana, West Africa.


Nursery Seeks Pre-School Pupils, Moms
