Carolina Humorist Talks To Dinner Club Saturday

Edmund H. Harding, who has distinguished himself as a Kentucky Colonel, Arkansas Traveler, Texas Ranger, and an officer of the Confederate Air Corps in addition to being a lifetime member of the Junior Chamber of Commerce, will be guest speaker at the May meeting of the Executive Dinner Club Saturday night at the Allen Center on Terminal Island.

Harding, who was born and still lives in Washington, N. C., is billed as the Tarheel Humorist, according to Dr. J. H. Hull, president of the host club.

The son of an Episcopal rector and an organist of his church for more than 40 years, Harding began his speaking career when he was elected district governor of Rotary International. He was in the fertilizer business at the time, but discovered "folks would pay more for humor than they would for humus."

Since he began his rounds speaking for Rotary, he has averaged about 150 talks a year in all 48 mainland states and the new state of Alaska. He also counts in talks in Mexico and Canada, and trips to Europe in search of humor.

He has been appointed North Carolina's Ambassador of Good Will by Gov. Luther H. Hodges.

College, two cash prizes in national contests for choral works, and a cash award from the University of Southern California in 1930 for the best setting of the "Semi-Centennial Ode," a major work for men's chorus, women's chorus, mixed voices, organ and orchestra, which won her a Master of Music degree from that University in 1934.

MISS WOODWORTH is a member of Phi Beta, Phi Kappa, Phi and Phi Kappa Lambda National professional and honorary sororities of music. In 1952 she received an Alumni Award from Grinnell College, from which institution she had received a large portion of her early musical education and her Bachelor of Music degree. She has also recently been awarded a place in "Who's Who in California."
