

Divine Law Is Credited With Man's Healing

Alignment with divine law brings true health, harmony, and dominion, Clifford R. Nysewander of Indianapolis, told an audience here last Friday.

The Christ-message of God's goodness and power presents a practical answer to humanity's problems, both individual and collective, Mr. Nysewander declared.

Currently on extended tour as member of The Christian Science Board of Lectureship, he spoke under the auspices of First Church of Christ, Scien-

tist, Torrance, in the church edifice, Manuel Ave. and 218th St. His subject was "Christian Science: Practical Christianity Revealed and Demonstrated." He was introduced by Henry J. Moreau, first reader.

Divine healing results from spiritual understanding of God linked with obedience of His laws, the lecturer stated.
