Help Offered Area Boys in Entering Soap Box Derby

Deadline Nears On Veterans' Tax Exemption

Veterans of this country are reminded by Veterans Service Officer Sara R. Bridges that Monday, May 25, at 5 p.m. is the deadline on filing for the \$1000 property tax exemption granted resident veterans of this state.

The Assessor's office has been accepting applications for the exemption since March 2, and under state law the closing deadline is the last Monday in May.

All requests for exemption on the first \$1000 of assessed valuation must be renewed annually, the service officer emphasized. This applies to both city and county applications. All property owned by the veterans must be considered in determining his eligibility for an exemption, including property outside this county. Eligibility is limited to veterans, including women veterans, who do not own property worth \$5000 or more. Under California's community property laws, this means a veteran and his wife may jointly own property up to \$10,000 assessed value and still qualify.

Veterans' widows, widowed mothers, or pensioned mothers and fathers of deceased veterans also may qualify. Tax exemptions of \$5000 are granted

Veterans who apply for the exemption are urged to exercise great care in filling out the application, and to be sure it lists all pertinent information.
