

Los Cancioneros To Present Double Bill of Musical Fare

A double bill of musical fare will be presented by Los Cancioneros, South Bay Concert Choral, at their ninth annual concert this weekend.

Appearing at Redondo Union High School auditorium at 8:30 p.m. tomorrow and Saturday, the concert group will split the program into a formal choral presentation before the intermission and a theatrical review, "The Best of Broadway," during the second half of the evening.

Under the direction of Barbara Mabin of Rolling Hills, the formal choral presentation will include: folk song solos by Walker Brown, who will accompany himself on the guitar; a duet from "Let Us Break Bread Together," by Trudi Troy and Bob Werley; and perennial favorite of Los Cancioneros audiences, "Black is the Color of My True Love's Hair," accompanied by Doris Welton, harpist.

Included in the "Best of Broadway" repertoire, directed by Jim Brittan of Manhattan Beach, will be songs from "Guys and Dolls," "My Fair Lady," and "The Music Man." Among the soloists will be Eliza Doolittle, Irene Roberts, and Gloria Yokabaitis. The Men's Quartette will also sing. Beach Orchestra Plans Season's Final Concert

Composer-Conductor Louis Palange leads the Beach Cities Symphony Orchestra in the fourth and final concert of the 1958-59 season, Friday, June 5, at 8:15 p.m., in Redondo Union High School's auditorium. "With Palange's customary distinctive flair for interesting and unusual programming, a stimulating evening is in prospect for the ever-growing audience that by now has come to expect and receive the finest in music this side of Philharmonic Auditorium." So says Dr. George C. Andersen, President of the Beach Cities Symphony Association, prominent physician and surgeon, and Hermosa Beach's "Man of the Year" in 1957.

Hector Berlioz' "Roman Carnival" Overture is a rousing pulse-stirrer for an opener, followed by the lovely nocturne "Liebestraume" (Dreams of Love) by Franz Liszt. Two Beach Cities Members, concertmaster Alex Pierce and Jack Shulman, both entering their fourth year of near-perfect attendance with the orchestra, combine their artistry in the celebrated "double concerto" for two violins and orchestra, by Johann Sebastian Bach. "Pavane pour une infante defunte" is a superbly orchestrated short work of France's Maurice Ravel. Heard for the first time locally, will be a chorus of mixed voices and solo quartet, accompanied by full symphony orchestra, as Palange directs the huge aggregate in Anton Bruckner's "Te Deum Laudamus". Featured is the Manhattan Motet, founder-leader Walter Slike, and soloists Charmion Ward, soprano, Helen Fowler, contralto, George Bailey, tenor, and Don Orgen, baritone. Musicians for this performance are provided by a grant from the Music Performance Trust Funds of the Recording Industries with the cooperation of Local 47 of the American Federation of Musicians.


