## Some FRontier Phones to Get Automatic Ticketing

Torrance residents whose telephone number begins with FRontier 2- or 4- or 6- or 9- must dial the prefix FR, beginning on Sunday, March 2, to reach any FRontier telephone number.

H. C. Vaupel, manager of the General Telephone Co.'s FRontier number area, announced that subscribers in FRontier 5-, 7- and 8- will continue to dial just the five digits of FRontier telephone numbers, without dialing the prefix," he added.

**Subscribers Told**  
Telephone subscribers who will be affected by the change have already been notified by means of an enclosure in their bill.

Reason for the change in dialing procedure stems from the fact that the Redondo central office of the Redondo exchange will convert to automatic toll-ticketing on April 6, according to Vaupel. The automatic equipment that provides toll-ticketing operates on a seven-cycle basis, necessitating the dialing of a prefix and five digits, he explained.

Although automatic toll-ticketing has extremely complicated equipment, it has a relatively simple working routine.

**Electronic Operation**  
When you pick up your phone to make a call, a series of electronic operations is set in motion before you even hear the dial tone. One device selects your line and clears it. Another, called a director, analyzes the number you dial and activates other units for routing your call and identifying your telephone number.

When you make a toll call, a unit known as the ticketer makes a record of your number, the number you are calling and computes the length of time of the call.

After you hang up, a tabulator and a date-timer records the exact time of day when the call was completed and transmits the information to a perforating machine that transcribes the history of the call on a strip of punched tape. This tape is collected on reels, much the same as movie films, and transported to the General

Telephone Co.'s revenue accounting center at the end of each day.

**Tapes Processed**  
An electric brain processes the tapes and produces a slotted card for each toll call completed that day. The cards are subsequently processed by electronic calculating machines which automatically and accurately express the amount of message unit charge as it appears on each customer's monthly statement. Vaupel noted. "It is highly important to dial all numbers correctly,

since each call is accepted and completed exactly as it is dialed. Incorrect dialing can only result in a wrong number."
