

# Jargon of Dope User Helpful to Officers

 "On the hype" means to be taking dope via the hypodermic needle; "connection" is a peddler; "doing business" means selling dope; "junk" is dope; "caps, papers, spoons" are quantities of heroin, referring to the method of preparation; "getting kicks, high on junk" are terms indicating an addict is under the influence.

**Informers Tagged**  
 "Heat, fuzz, whiskers" are terms used for the law or police officers; "fink, stoolie, rat" indicate an informer; "looking buzzing," are trying to buy narcotics.  
 Marijuana cigarettes can be referred to as "stick, reefer, roach, griefo, pot, mari, tea and pod." The drug itself is known as "yesea, weed, hay, grass, jive, and charge."  
 "Shooting gallery" is the name for a peddler's place of

business, if an addict can get a "fix" there. "Pad" is the hypo's home and "bread" is the money used to buy dope. "A paddy" is a Caucasian using dope. "paddy chick," a girl dope user, "chicano" is a Mexican user; and "grays" and "grey chicks" are Negro users. This is only a portion of the strange dialect used in the bleak half-reality world of "junk"—the narcotic addict.

**Terms Useful**  
 A narcotics training manual used by police officers, stresses the importance of learning

these terms. Officers, according to the manual, can detect a hitherto unknown source of potential trouble just by watching for these common expressions.  
 Unfortunately, the language used by the addicts holds a certain amount of fascination and glamour for today's juveniles. They have picked up many of these expressions and use them often in their conversation. Just because teenagers use

some of this slang talk, doesn't mean they are narcotic addicts. The jargon is only one means of aiding police officers in their investigations. It is one of the many tell-tale signs. There are others.

# Science Test Program Set

A testing program to determine what high school science classes students should take will be started in the Torrance Unified School District, according to Assistant Superintendent Albert Posner.  
 The test will be administered to all eighth grade students to determine what courses the student is qualified to take. The test will emphasize biology and physics, but will include astronomy, geology and meteorology.  
 The program, Posner said, is designed to:  
 1. Program faster learners

into more advanced science courses and to avoid forcing them to repeat work which they may already have had.  
 2. Enable elementary schools to evaluate their science programs and effectiveness of instruction there.  
 3. Enable high schools to evaluate the adequacy of their science programs.  
 Scores will be placed in the students' guidance files and elementary principals will receive reports on all students from his school who take the test.


