

Rev. McLean was born of missionary parents in Chile. His last two pastorates were at the First Presbyterian Church of Santa Barbara and the First Presbyterian Church at Yakima, Wash. In 1950 he retired. Since then he has been traveling.

In 1953 he and his wife ran the language school at San Jose, Costa Rica, which trains missionaries in Spanish before going to their fields. This is an interdenominational school.

Last year he served as pastor at the Union Church at Tegucigalpa, Honduras. He has written six books. Four are for children, on a missionary theme.

They both travel in the winters and spend their summers at Lake Chelan, Ctehelkin, Wash.
