

Largest Lamp Bulb Goes On Display Here

A 75,000 watt incandescent lamp bulb, the world's largest bulb, will be on display at Jim Dandy's new West Torrance market, Sepulveda Blvd. at Hawthorne Ave., this week end.

The lamp produces 2,400,000 lumens or units of light. To produce this amount of light would require 2874 60-watt household bulbs, all burning simultaneously. The huge lamp is so bright and hot that observers are advised not to look at it or stand close to it when it is burning.

The lamp was built in 1954, on the 75th anniversary of the first practical incandescent lamp invented by Edison. Developed by General Electric Co., the huge lamp will be on display until May 12.
