## Mental Health Bills Designed To Destroy Individual Freedom

Speaking before the monthly breakfast meeting of the Torrance Chamber of Commerce Tuesday, Dr. Louis Aleson described so-called Mental Health legislation as "designed to destroy individual freedoms."

"Let's take the wrappings off and see what's in the package and discover that basically the program as revealed in the writings of G. B. Chisholm and Bertrand Russell destroys the

precepts of church and home," he declared.

Conceding that many proponents of mental health bills are sincere and purposeful in their efforts, Dr. Aleson nevertheless insisted there was a pattern of socialism and "robotism" apparent in the current drive to establish local clinics under state and federal control. The Short-Doyle Act, he said, takes away all local autonomy.

### Hits Dewey System

Dr. Aleson, a vigorous and articulate foe of socialized medicine, opened his address with a strong appeal for the retention of the old and tried patient-family physician relationship. He cracked out at the so-called progressive education system as originated by John Dewey insisting that it encouraged "flight from personal responsibility in favor of group anonymity."

The speaker was introduced by R. A. Stetson, prominent Torrance physician and surgeon.

Presiding at the meeting attended by 97 was Keith Border of Border's Market. Rev. Hugh Percy, rector of St. Andrew's Episcopal church, gave the invocation and benediction. An added feature at the meeting was the presentation of a plaque from the Chamber to Mrs. Minot Rugg of the Torrance Terrace Garden club who was in charge of the city's entry in the International Flower Show. 




