Brad Trenham List Problems Facing State

"Reduction of government spending will be the most important single issue facing the Legislature next year," Brad Trenham, Republican candidate for State Senator from Los Angeles County declared today.

"For unless this is done, the more than 250 million dollar deficit that we face will be only the beginning and will seriously undermine the financial structure of the state."

Trenham warned voters that "the primary is less than a week away and that they should be concerned with electing economy-minded people to the legislature, so that the steady increase of government spending and taxes can be stopped."

Other major state problems listed by Trenham, an authority for more than 30 years on government, taxation and economy, were water education and highways.
