**SUMMER CLASSES SET TO OPEN NEXT MONDAY**

Summer school classes will begin next Monday in all Torrance schools, giving nearly a third of the regular school children only a week's vacation. Classes will let out on July 31.

More than 8800 youngsters have signed up for the summer sessions which will be a continuation of the regular year's program. Classes are designed to help all students. Some 1900 high school and 6900 elementary students have signed up.

Classes are scheduled to start between 8 and 8:30 p.m. at local elementary schools, with high school classes set at 8 a.m.

Classes will be held at all schools except North High and Fern Elementary School, where construction work will be in progress. NHS classes will be at South High School, with students going by bus to the SHS campus. No other students will be transported to school.

Fern students will attend classes at neighborhood Greenwood School.

More than 800 eighth grade students have signed up for the six-week sessions. They will be able to take a number of courses, including many for credit.
