

NOVEMBER ELECTION IS FORECAST FOR WATER

An election on formation of a water replenishment district to encompass the areas of the West Basin and Central Basin Water Districts will probably be held about Nov. 17, according to a timetable worked out by officials of the district this week.

Carl Fossette, executive secretary of the two districts, reported that petitions filed by the districts with Benjamin S. Hite, county registrar of voters, had exceeded the required minimum by an ample margin with more than 80 percent of the signers proving valid.

A public hearing on the proposal has been called for July 6 in Los Angeles by the state director of water resources. If the findings of that hearing can be returned to the board of supervisors by July 21, the Nov. 17 election date is probable, Fossette said.

Executive committees of the West Basin and Central Basin are preparing exhibits and testimony for the July 6 public hearing, the water official said.

Rehearsals for the summer months by the three groups of the Torrance Area Youth Bands will begin this week.

The Junior Band, composed of students of elementary school age, will be held on Thursday mornings from 9:30 to 11:30. The Youth Band for high school age students will be held on Thursday from 7 to 9 p.m. The Concert Band, for advanced high school age students and college age musicians, will be held on Monday from 7 to 9 p.m. All rehearsals are held in the Torrance Civic Auditorium. Regular rehearsals will be held throughout the summer.

All three bands will play several programs in the park and around Torrance during the summer. The Youth Band will play for the Rancho Days Parade in July as well as the Miss Universe Pageant in Long Beach; also during the month of July.

A small membership fee is charged each student to help defray expenses of music and uniforms.

James Van Dyck and Jim Davidson will have charge of the summer program. Davidson also will handle the "Fun Through Music" program for the recreation department.
