### God's Presence Is Sermon Topic

One of the highlights in the lesson-sermon at all Christian Science services on Sunday is the account of the healing by Jesus of the woman who had been bound with an infirmity eighteen years. The subject of the sermon is "God." The Golden Text taken from Psalms (46:1) declares, "God is our refuge and strength, a very pleasant help in trouble."

The Bible account in Luke of the woman ill for eighteen years says she was "bowed together, and could in no wise lift up herself," but after Jesus had called to her that she was "loosed from (her) infirmity," Luke writes, "And immediately she was made straight, and glorified God" (13:11-13).

"God will heal the sick through man, whenever man is governed by God," comments a correlative passage from "Science and Health with Key to the Scriptures" by Mary Baker Eddy. It later continues "Then classify sickness and error as our Master did, when he spoke of the sick, 'whom Satan hath bound,' and find a sovereign antidote for error in the life-giving power of Truth acting on human belief, a power which opens the prison doors to such as are bound, and sets the captive free physically and morally" (p. 495).
