Two Torrance Men Join State Highway Patrol

Two Torrance men, Robert E. Wright, 32, of 21738 Redbeam Ave. and Paul J. Zangger of 411 Fiat St., joined the California Highway Patrol recently and are currently receiving training at the patrol's academy in Sacramento for 12 weeks.

The new traffic officers will receive instruction in more than 50 subjects related to traffic law enforcement. Emphasis is placed on the California vehicle code, traffic supervision, accident investigation, first aid, preservation of evidence, court systems and legal procedures, and equipment operation and maintenance. The current class is made up of 54 men from all parts of California.




