### Start Construction of \$2,000,000 Del Amo Center Medical Building

Start of construction of the first half of the \$2,000,000 Del Amo Center Medical Building project in Torrance was announced this week by Millard W. Jacobs and Stuart M. Ketchum, managing partners of Carter Company, Contractors and Developers, who assisted in the financing and development of the project and are constructing the building. Located on Hawthorne Blvd. between Carson Ave. and Torrance Blvd., the completed project will consist of two 32,500-square-foot modern buildings on a five acre site. The development is owned by Hawthorne Medical Building, a California corporation with twenty South Bay doctors and dentists as stockholders. The board of directors consists of Dr. Herschel S. Kopp, president; Dr. Robert McCormick and Dr. Richard McClure, Dr. Matthew Romeo is secretary.

Designed by Jones, Lockett & Popper, Long Beach architects, the building will be of contemporary styling. Architectural treatment of the front facade features the use of vertical masonry panels alternating with window panels of glass and porcelain. The structure will be of steel frame, reinforced concrete and masonry construction. Mechanical and electrical equipment, plus utility and storage areas will be accommodated in the basement. IN DESCRIBING the two-story building now under construction, Jacobs said it will contain a basement and will house approximately twenty-five suits with occupants representing all branches of medicine and dentistry, together with advanced radiological and pathological laboratories. A modern pharmacy will be located on the ground floor. The entire building will be air-conditioned. Land for the project is owned by Del Amo Estate Co., Los Angeles, and is leased to Hawthorne Medical Building on a long term lease.

COLDWELL Banker & Co., statewide realtors, handled the property negotiations and have been appointed exclusive leasing agents for the building. Commitments have already been made for over 75 per cent of the total occupancy available. According to Peter di Fran-
