AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TORRANCE, REPEALING SECTION 16.395 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF TORRANCE, 1954, RELATING TO INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS FOR TAXICABS, AND SUBSTITUTING NEW PROVISIONS THEREFOR.

The City Council of the City of Torrance does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1.
That Section 16.395 of "The Code of the City of Torrance, 1954," relating to insurance requirements for taxicabs, is hereby repealed, and the following provisions substituted therefor:

Section 16.395. Insurance.
(a) Before a license for taxicabs shall be issued the applicant shall have filed with the license inspector a certificate showing that applicant has in effect an insurance policy which will insure and indemnify the applicant and the passengers riding in applicant's taxicabs against liability or financial loss resulting from injury occurring to persons or passengers from the operation of such vehicles in an amount not less than \$20,000.00 for bodily injury to any one person, \$40,000.00 for any one accident, and \$5,000.00 per person for property damage.

(b) Said policy shall be issued by an insurer rated in Best's Insurance Guide with a financial rating of AAA or better. Said policy shall provide that the insurance coverage shall not be cancelled or reduced by the insurance carrier without the city having been given ten days prior written notice thereof by such carrier. In the event that such insurance coverage is

cancelled, revoked, or otherwise terminated, the license issued to the owner or operator of such taxicabs shall be automatically terminated.

SECTION 2.
Any provision of the Torrance City Code, or appendices thereto, inconsistent herewith, to the extent of such inconsistency and no further, are hereby repealed.
