

Fall School Bus Schedules for Torrance District Announced

Torrance school busses, which last year carried some 630,000 children nearly 400,000 miles, are ready again this fall to carry youngsters to local schools.

Busses will carry students in high schools if they live more than two miles away. Elementary students are transported if they live more than a mile away.

Despite an increase in enrollment, fewer students will be bussed to school this year. Seven new schools were opened last year bringing buildings closer to the students and requiring less service. Students will be bussed to three high schools and nine of the district's 28 elementary schools. Busses also will be used to carry youngsters on field trips.

The district hires 17 drivers full-time and 10 part-time. The part-time drivers drive cars to transport handicapped children.

Only variation from the announced bus schedules will be on the day before school opens, when busses will carry freshmen to their high schools for orientation. North and Torrance High students will be picked up at 8:10 a.m. on Sept. 9, while South High pupils will be picked up at 8:40 p.m. at the listed stops.

Released Time Religious Study Program Slated

At a recent meeting the board of education approved the program for released time education in the elementary schools of the Torrance Unified School District for the year 1959-1960.

Under this permission the principal of each elementary school sends a letter to the home of each pupil in grades 4, 5, and 6 explaining the religious released time program. With each letter goes a card which the parents may sign if they wish to enroll their children in either faith group.

IN CONFERENCE with the principal of each school the interfaith committee arranges a satisfactory time for dismissal from each school. Thereafter, the children whose parents have requested religious instruction are released one hour a week to the religious teachers.

Two groups provide classes for the schools, the Roman Catholic and the Evangelical Protestant. The Catholics may obtain any added information from Rev. Glenn at the Torrance Rectory, FA 8-2779. Protestants may contact Miss Irene Mills at DA 6-3120.

Parents are encouraged to enroll their children in these classes for religious instruction in order that they may profit from a systematic study of the faith of their choice. All children of the Torrance Unified District are welcome to be entered in the classes, Miss Mills said.


