

County Gets Two Million For Highways

Assemblyman Vincent Thomas announced today that Los Angeles County received \$2,247,903.28 as its share of highway users taxes distributed in August by State Controller Alan Cranston's office.

Statewide apportionments for the month totaled \$30,345,880, the Assemblyman said. That sum was divided among the State, counties and cities in the following amounts: \$20,700,628 to the State

Highway Fund for expenditure on highways. \$6,954,564 to the counties. \$2,690,688 to the State Highway Fund for cities. The money must be used for the construction or maintenance of highways, streets, and roads.


Jewish Council Sets School Registration
