**Final Plans for Harbor Hospital Being Checked**

Plans for the new \$15,400,000 Harbor General Hospital have now been submitted to the County Engineer for checking and review three months ahead of the original time schedule, Supervisor Kenneth Hahn said yesterday.  
"This means that construction on this badly needed new hospital can be started this much sooner so that the people of the southwest section of Los Angeles County will have good hospital facilities available to them," Hahn declared.  
Planning for the new hospital had bogged down last year when Hahn demanded that the work of the architects be speeded up.  
As a result of his efforts, the preliminary plans were approved last December and the final drawings will soon be ready for advertising for bids, he said.  
He pointed out that the new hospital was approved by the people of Los Angeles County at a bond election in November, 1956 and that four architectural firms were assigned to do the project a week later.
