

### Registration Law Changes

Owners of vehicles which are not registered for the current year and which are left standing on any public street or highway must meet a new registration requirement added to the California Vehicle Code by a 1959 statute.

Robert McCarthy, Director of Motor Vehicles, today alerted owners to an Oct. 17 deadline for registration of such vehicles.

"The new law requiring vehicles parked or left standing on public streets and highways to be registered, whether they are operated during the current year or not, took effect Sept. 18, 1959," McCarthy said. "From the date when registration becomes due, owners have 30 additional days in which to comply with the law. After Oct. 17, the Department of Motor Vehicles will be obligated to collect on delinquent registration fees, when application is made in any field office or through the mail.

"We are broadcasting this alert to enable motorists to avoid the extra cost of paying penalties due to ignorance of the law. Even though the vehicle left standing on a highway is not moved this year, it would be necessary to collect 1959 fees and penalties along with 1960 fees, if the application is not submitted until next year."

The "standing" vehicles affected by the law include passenger cars, trucks, trailers, semi-trailers, and dollies of all types. A technical exemption is made in the statute for vehicles owned by dealers in connection with loading and unloading operations in the dealer's business, unless prohibited by other laws.
