World Traveling Photographer To Show Films Here on Sunday

Edwin C. Udey, who has been filming far away places and people for 20 years, will show films on "Children of Tanganyika" Sunday evening at the South Bay Baptist Church, 4565 Sharyne Lane, according to Dr. J. C. Brumfield, pastor.

Udey's films will show the life of African children in the "Big Game" country, in mud huts, in mission schools, and they will describe how lepers live, how blind boys are taught, and give an "inside" story of tomorrow's leaders as they live today, Dr. Brumfield said.
