

Woman Seeking Dog Which Flew From Racing Car

Mrs. Lee Mountain of 5123 Carol Drive, whose 15-year-old dog, Trixie, is like "one of the family," is asking for help today.

Mrs. Mountain, who is visiting her daughter, Mrs. Richard Studdard, at 2264 W. 247th St., Thursday evening, said she was standing in her daughter's front yard with the aging pet when a "hot-rod jerk" went screaming around the corner, frightening the dog.

Trixie ran across Lomita Blvd., with Mrs. Mountain, her daughter, and a service station attendant in pursuit.

The pet, in panic, disappeared near Lomita Blvd. and Cypress Ave., and has not been located.

The dog has been described as black, a cross between a wire hair and sheep dog, with graying circles around the eyes. She sees and hears poorly, and has never been away from home in the 15 years of her life with the Mountain family.

No provision to drain the water has been made, and the constantly annoying, water-filled hole has been described as a menace to vehicle traffic and pedestrians alike.

Lane, who lives nearby, tried to get county help in repairing the mudhole, but has not been able to get a reply to letters.
