State Mental Health Facilities Growing

Many people have been asking about the mental health programs, and especially about State expenditures. The Legislative Council in his Opinion No. 780, dated Nov. 17, 1959, based largely upon a letter from the Legislative Analyst dated Nov. 16, 1959, contained the following information:

The total State budget expenditure for the 1957-58 Fiscal Year was \$7,083. The first programs began operating only during the last half of the year on a limited level.

The costs to the State for mental health benefits in the Fiscal Year July 1, 1958 to June 30, 1959 have been estimated at \$1,500,000. Due to slowness of the individual facilities in submitting claims for reimbursement to the State, final figures are not yet available.

THERE ARE 11 separate county programs and one city program in effect by June 30, 1959. The counties are Alameda, Contra Costa, Kern, Monterey, San Francisco (City and County), San Joaquin, San Mateo, Santa Clara, Santa Cruz, Sonoma, and Ventura. The only city was San Jose.

The only new program to date since June 30, 1959, is the Los Angeles County program. Therefore, the total is now 12 county programs and one city program.

There is no basis for estimating the cost of operating a clinic unless a vast amount of detailed facts are presented. The San Jose City mental health program includes only hospitalization and consultative services and is not an outpatient as yet. Outpatient clinics vary greatly in size and therefore costs would appear to be largely representative of

the available resources in the community as against a strict population ratio.

OUTPATIENT clinic costs in the Short-Doyle program are presently running between about \$5 and \$15 per patient visit, but costs are rapidly increasing and the number of patients in the different case-loads vary widely for the separate programs.

Incidentally, Senate Bill 705, which passed both houses of the Legislature and was then vetoed by the Governor, would have increased the State share of the reimbursement formula.

The above information was obtained after a vast amount of research and was set in motion by letters from women in Inglewood, Westchester, Playa del Rey, El Segundo, Manhattan Beach, Hermosa Beach, Redondo Beach, the Hollywood Riviera section of Torrance, Palos Verdes Estates, Rolling Hills, and Portuguese Bend. Some women even wrote from Avalon.

FORTUNATELY, all wrote specific questions which I am glad to answer. If you want more information about State problems, always write to me at Post Office Box 777, Inglewood 5, and be very specific in your questions. Requests such as "Tell me all about the Short-Doyle mental health program" are too general and would require several text-books to answer.

Incidentally, this appears to be a very controversial subject. Some people are for the program and others against it.
