One of the largest Y's in Asia, the Seoul, Korea, building was saturated with oil and kerosene and reported burned by the Communists in 1950. All that remained was a broken outer wall. Yet, within this shell over 1500 Korean youngsters receive their only educa-

tion. Y Secretaries still manage to run sports and recreation programs, adult education courses, a library, church, gym classes and a multiplicity of service projects for refugees and other victims of war.

The YMCA of Nazareth, Israel is located in a run-down building across the street from an attractive Communist youth center. Each building blares forth with vigorous appeals inviting the youth into their respective programs. The future of these youths and the Near East may depend on which door they will enter. Will the YMCA challenge people in Nazareth as Jesus did when he lived there? Is a question asked by many.
