El Camino Geology Teacher Receives NSF Grant Award

Bernard W. Pipkin became the third El Camino College instructor of science to receive honors from the National Science Foundation, when he was named this week as the recipient of a NSF grant.

Under terms of the award, the college geology instructor will do advanced work in his field at the University of Arizona during the 1960-61 school year. Pipkin is a Torrance resident. Jack Hileman, El Camino College chemistry instructor, was named previously as the recipient of a grant which will enable him to study at UCLA.

A third member of the college faculty was honored by the NSF recognition a year ago, when Peter Mel, counselor and biological science instructor was named winner of an award which took him to UCLA for graduate study.

Pipkin has been an instructor at El Camino since 1956. He was born in Los Angeles and received all of his education in the Los Angeles area. While at the University of Southern California, he received both his bachelor and masters degrees, majoring in geology. He served as a teaching assistant in the department of geology on the USC campus while a student there.

Service in the U. S. Marine Corps during both World War II and the Korean conflict interrupted his education sequence.

Pipkin worked for a year as a geologist with the U. S. Army Engineering Corps in the civilian branch. Last summer he was on a NSF fellowship which enabled him to study nearshore and coastal geography in waters off Florida, the Bahamas and Jamaica.

"It is a wonderful opportunity," the award winner declared. "It is also a wonderful program. The awards are made for both advanced graduate study and research."

The instructor is an associate member of The Society of Sigma Xi, and a member of the Petroleum Engineers and the Association of Geology Teachers. He is active in Sigma Gamma Epsilon, national geological fraternity.




