Improvement Of Crenshaw

Improvement of the intersection of Redondo Beach and Crenshaw Bldgs. has been started by County road crews. Supervisor Kenneth Hahn announced this week.

Work will include resurfacing of the intersection to reduce present roadway maintenance costs and improve the riding quality of the street. He urges motorists to use caution when traveling through the construction area.

Hehn adds that both boulevards are major highways on the County Master Plan of Highways. Recent traffic counts indicate that approximately 35,000 vehicles cross this intersection daily.
