

Realty Board President to Take Course

Lee R. Dawson, newly elected president of the Torrance-Lomita Board of Realtors, will attend the annual officers' indoctrination program conducted by the 31,000 member California Real Estate Assn. at the Biltmore Hotel in Los Angeles on Friday, Jan. 8, it was announced by H. Jackson Pontius, executive vice president of the association.

Training sessions will also be conducted for local real estate

board secretaries, and Irene Baker, secretary of the Torrance-Lomita Board, will attend this session. The regional vice-president of CREA for the area, Jack K. Tarney, of Gardena, will attend a special session of the training program devoted to preparing the 28 regional vice-presidents of the state association for the many activities and duties involved in that office.

L. Callahan of Los Angeles, will be installed as president of the California Real Estate Assn. at an inaugural luncheon meeting to be held at the Biltmore Hotel. Callahan is past president of the Los Angeles Realty Board and will be the 53rd president of CREA, now representing 165 local real estate boards in California.
