### Assemblyman Porter Says Senate Changes Won't Hurt Water Vote

A charge that the program to reapportion the State Senate will endanger the State Water Program was refuted this week by Assemblyman Carley V. Porter (D-Compton), chairman of the Joint Legislative Water Committee.

Porter is recognized as one of the authorities in the state on California's water problem. Hundreds of volunteer petition circulators are now gathering signatures to qualify an initiative petition to be presented to the voters at the Nov. 8 election, Doherty said.

"In my opinion they are separate issues entirely and I do not feel that the presence of Reapportionment on the ballot will in any way hurt the Water Bond Act."

Porter said that the program to reapportion the State Senate will endanger the State Water Program was refuted this week by Assemblyman Carley V. Porter (D-Compton), chairman of the Joint Legislative Water Committee.

Frank P. Doherty, chairman of the Committee for Equitable Representation in the State Senate, said opponents of the plan have stated the move "may be a good thing, but it is ill-timed" because it may hurt the water issue, which also will appear on the Nov. 8, 1960, general election ballot.

HOWEVER, Porter told Al Horton, chairman of the Southeast Area Committee for Senate Reapportionment:

The proposed amendment for

reapportionment would give 13 Southern California counties with more than 65 per cent of the state's total population and 63 per cent of the state's tax and other revenues, 20 of the Senate's 40 senators.

AT PRESENT, there are 32 senators from the area north of the Tehachapi Mountains and only eight senators for the area to the south.

Doherty said citizens who volunteer to circulate the petition may do so by writing the Committee's headquarters, 617 South Olive, Suite 500, Los Angeles 14, or calling MADison 7-3776.

### Telephone Company Lists New Films Now Available

Five new colored films have been added to General Telephone Company's film library, which are now available to schools, churches, civic groups, service clubs and other organizations on a "free loan" basis, said J. M. White, Palos Verdes district manager.

"The Big Reach," a 27 minute film, geared for all age groups, starting with elementary, depicts the Air Force's attempts to reach the moon during the fall of 1958. It shows the difficulties and problems involved; relates comments made by individuals directly connected with the project and shows, through animation, how the moon will be reached through space.

"The Long Right Arm," a 30 minute film, is a story of the evolutionary progress made in logistical aviation, the airlift concept, illustrated with the DC-3 through the DC-4, 5, and 6 series, C-124 and ending with the C-133. Historical sequences depict the airlift effort through World War II, the Berlin Airlift, Korea and the present IRBM and ICBM logistical support capability.

"The Schooner Goodwill," a story of the "Goodwill's" race to Honolulu in 1955 runs for 30 minutes. Donald Douglas, Jr., and other Douglas executives were among the crew. Appealing to viewers starting with the junior high school level up through adult groups, this film is an excellent yachting film for yacht clubs and other interested groups.

THE ABOVE four films have been produced by Douglas Aircraft Co.

"Russia," a documentary film produced by Walt Disney Studios, runs for 24 minutes. It begins with a priceless motion picture record, taken between 1905 and 1910, of the last Tzar and his family in court ceremonies and workmen of that period.

Then, fifty years later and in color, we see Soviet Russia today, with modern housing, agriculture and industry. Photographed by Julien Bryan, with authentic Russian music, throughout, this film is simple, well balanced an interesting.
