

ECC Athletes Honored at Sports Banquet

Gene Williams, who sparked El Camino College to one of its biggest upsets of the junior college year, a 28-12 victory over Santa Monica last week, was rewarded for his season-long fetes at the semi-annual Athletic Awards Banquet.

COACH NORM VERRY presented Williams with three individual honors, including the "most inspirational player of

the year," and he was tabbed the Warriors' outstanding defensive halfback, and most improved player of the year.

GEORGE HAHLEBECK, two-year varsity letterman, was presented the outstanding offensive lineman trophy.

Rookie Joe Costanza was named best defensive lineman, while Billie Reames was awarded best all-around lineman.

Dave Long, an all-Metropolitan Conference quarterback, was named top offensive back.

Coach Ray Southstone announced Furman Marsh most valuable runner on the cross country team, while Matt Hamilton received the same honor for water polo.

TOM SWEENEY, a water poloist, was revealed as the best athletic scholar for the fall semester.

Star-Studded Attraction at Santa Anita

Santa Anita presents a star-studded double attraction Saturday to climax its fourth full week of Thoroughbred racing. An outpouring of fans is expected to see the action on the spectacular hillside-infield turf course and the main mile track.

The \$25,000 San Marcos Handicap at 1 1/4 miles has attracted top grass runners from all parts of the world, with Nichol Boy, Eddie Schmidt, Greek Star, Promised Land, Whodunit and How Now among the 20 nominations expected to start.

INTERNATIONAL lustre will be in evidence with Onward There from Japan making his first appearance.

THE \$25,000 San Pasqual Handicap at 1 1/16 miles has the nationally-ranked Hillsdale nominated to make his first appearance of the season. All depends on how his ailing ankle heals. Seaneen is also eligible as are Clandestine, the top sprinter that has already won two stakes in the "Silver Jubilee" meeting, Finnegan, Fleet Nasrullah and other good ones.

Scheduled during the week was the \$15,000 Santa Ynez Stakes on Tuesday and today's \$25,000 Santa Maria Handicap with feature races named for Downey, Rancho San Luis Rey, Wise Daughter, El Monte, Hollywood Bowl, Huntington Art Gallery, Conejo Ranch, Bluebeard, Fontana, Southern California Exposition and Fullerton.

NEXT SATURDAY comes the first of Santa Anita's four "hundred granders" — the estimated \$170,000 Maturity.
