Youth Governor Signs Thirteen Model Statutes

A total of 13 bills were signed by the Youth Governor Linda Farley at the 12th Annual Model Legislature. After passing both the Senate and the Assembly, these 13 were sent to the Youth Governor's office and signed, thus making them into "laws".

During the three-day session, Senators and Assemblymen voted on 50 bills representing various clubs throughout the state. The Torrance bill, along with several others, could not be heard due to lack of time. One of the first bills sent to Linda Farley's office was veto-

ed by the 17-year-old Downey girl. Many did not have a chance to reach her office because they were "killed" in one of the houses. The delegates were entertained at a Legislator's Banquet Thursday evening and a Governor's Ball and Banquet Friday.

The 12-hour return trip from Sacramento was spent discussing action on various bills and making plans for next year's Model Legislature. All the delegates feel that this has been a memorable experience and hope to attend next year.

324 Torrance Students in Classes for Handicapped

Some 324 Torrance children are enrolled in classes for the handicapped, according to a report to the Board of Education.

Of these, 85 are enrolled in classes under the Southwest School Districts Cooperative program, in which seven

districts cooperate to provide training for children with various types of handicaps. The Southwest program provides for 254 students.

Some 239 children are enrolled in classes for the moderately mentally retarded. These are not part of the cooperative program.

The number of Torrance children in the various categories of the cooperative program include severely mentally retarded, 34; elementary deaf and hard of hearing, 14; elementary orthopedic and delicate (crippled by disease), 11; elementary blind, 5; elementary partially-sighted, 6; cerebral palsy, 5; itinerant blind and partially-sighted, 4; high school blind and partially-sighted, 3; high school orthopedic, 1; and neurologically handicapped (brain damage), 1.

Torrance provides schooling for blind, partially sighted, and severely mentally retarded children, while Inglewood, Lennox, Hawthorne, Lawndale, Wiseburn, and the Centinela Valley Union High School District provides schools for other types of handicaps.

Polio Clinic Slated

The monthly polio clinic of the MD Group, 4193 W. Redondo Beach Blvd., will be held from 2 to 8 p.m. on Tuesday, March 1, it was reported this week. Cost of the vaccinations will be \$1 each or \$5 maximum per family.

Corazzas to Tour Germany Next Month


