

In 46th District

El Camino Political Science Instructor to Oppose Chapel

Charles P. Sohner, instructor of political science at El Camino College for the last seven years, Monday took out filing papers as a candidate for the State Assembly in the June primary. Last month, Sohner was selected as the endorsed candidate by the 46th Assembly District Democratic Convention, to oppose Assemblyman Charles E. Chapel of Inglewood.

"The most important problem confronting the people of this district," Sohner stated, "is economic uncertainty due to fluctuating government contracts and the resulting unsteadiness of jobs, especially in the aircraft industry. This is a common concern to labor and business alike. It cuts across party lines and effects nearly every citizen in the district. We must greatly increase our efforts to bring new industry to this area and eliminate the haunting fear of unemployment."

"THIS WILL require a broad program on many fronts. We must eliminate the damaging effect of smog, not only upon our health and comfort but also upon our ability to attract

educational opportunity;

(3) increased vigilance by the Public Utility Commission in protecting the consumer's interest.

SOHNER, 31, stated he is seeking public office because of his deep belief that his years as a teacher have given him a keen insight into the needs of this area and that his training as a political scientist has equipped him to help meet them. He resides at 1210 Fifth St. in Manhattan Beach with his wife, Betty, and his two children, Nancy 7 and Danny 6.

His experience includes service on the faculties of the University of Southern California and Pepperdine College, the publication of magazine articles, and the writing of a political column. He is a graduate of Northwestern University and holds a master's degree from the University of Southern California.

OTHER POINTS in Sohner's platform include:

- (1) a new state constitution which will insure greater economy in government, fairer representation in the State Legislature, longer legislative sessions, and increased administrative efficiency;


