Adventists Help to Aid Area Needy

The Health and Welfare Services director of the Torrance Seventh-day Adventist Church, said today that the local church has given help to 218 persons in the Torrance community during the past three months.

Mrs. Bernice Moshos, 2570 Trotters Terrace, Rolling Hills, said cash value and aid given by the church totaled \$4,265.62 for the months of April, May and June, 1960.

"This example of Christian concern for those in need is heartening," Mrs. Moshos said. "It is an expression of love for mankind by persons in the church, an expression which is part of the privilege of Christianity."

Mrs. Moshos said the aid included 11 food baskets distributed and 1,792 articles of clothing given persons whose plight came to the attention of welfare workers of the Torrance Adventist Church.

A total of 576 hours of volunteer labor in repair and cleaning of clothing and pieces of furniture distributed is also revealed in the report, Mrs. Moshos stated.

Aid to needy persons in the community by the Seventh-day Adventist church is given without regard to race, color or creed. "The only guide we follow is that there be obvious need when it comes to those in need," said Mrs. Moshos.

Lesson-Sermon On 'Spirit' Slated Sunday

The Lesson-Sermon on "Spirit" continues the current series which brings out the nature, essence, and wholeness of God. The Golden Text is from I Corinthians (2:12), "Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the spirit which is God; that we might know the things that are freely given to us of God."

Mankind's opportunity to awaken to God-given freedom will be emphasized in all Christian Science churches on Sunday.

The Scriptural account of the imprisonment and deliverance of Paul and Silas, as related in The Acts (Ch. 16), includes the following citations, "And at midnight Paul and Silas prayed, and sang praises unto God; and the prisoners heard them. And suddenly there was a great earthquake, so that the foundations of the prison were shaken; and immediately all the doors were opened, and every one's bands were loosed" (16:25, 26).

"Discerning the rights of man, we cannot fail to foresee the doom of all oppression," declares Mary Baker Eddy in "Science and Health with Key to the Scriptures." She continues, "Slavery is not the legitimate state of man. God made man free. Paul said, 'I was free born.' All men should be free. 'Where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is liberty.' Love and Truth make free, but evil and error lead into captivity" (p. 227).
