

# Torrance YMCA Sets Record For Branch Camping Turnout

The Torrance YMCA has set a new youth program record this week with 240 boys and girls in mountain camp. The Torrance youngsters are accompanied by a staff of 54 counselors and program specialists.

One hundred and fifty boys are attending YMCA Camp Round Meadow under the leadership of Clemens Rybacki, camp director; Jack Breglio, program director; Rev. Gilbert Zimmerman, chaplain, and 14 additional fathers of children in camp.

Native lore, cook-outs, riflery, lean-to building, and Indian lore are the highlights of this big camp for local youth.

NINETY TORRANCE girls are

spending the week in YMCA Camp Mozumdar, with Alpha Renz as camp director. Assisting her are Mmes. Clemens Rybacki, John Stoneberg, Joseph Wilcox, Clifford Duncan, and a large group of cagin counselors.

Archery, horseback riding, handicrafts, campfires, and swimming highlight this period of fun for girls.

ACCORDING TO the Camp Branch of the Los Angeles YMCA, this constitutes a record group from one local YMCA Branch. Five buses were required to transport the children to the camps.

Six additional Torrance YMCA camps are still scheduled. On Aug. 13, boys 9 to 12

will depart for YMCA Camp Big Pines. Aug. 15 is the date set for the older boys participating in the YMCA's Sacramento River Boat Expedition. On the following day, 25 boys 12 and older will begin a week long caravan in the High Sierras, with fishing and sightseeing as major highlights.

ON SEPT. 2, men and boys 14 and older will begin a backpack hike along the famed John Muir Trail from Mammoth Lakes to Rock Creek Lake 54 miles south.

On Sept. 6, 20 local high school and college co-eds will depart for a Leadership Development Camp at Fawnskin.

The final camp of the summer will be a weekend Family Camp to be conducted at Big Pines. Twenty-five families have registered thus far.

# Garden Checklist

1. Try taming the robust Oleander by growing it in a tub. On a sunny deck it will give a real show of color.
2. Keep pinching Chrysanthemums to encourage bushy growth. Disbud side buds if you would have larger blooms on top.
3. The long canes of blackberry that bore fruit this year should be cut out if you haven't done it yet. New canes should be loosely wound around trellis.
4. Set out Bird of Paradise this month for exotic bloom through fall and winter.
5. Plant natives this month and next and keep them watered until winter rains take over. After the first year, few of them need any attention from the hose.

**CITRUS TREES**  
August is ideal for planting dwarf citrus trees. The warm days give the trees a good start. Make a basin around the tree for irrigation, but keep a mound of earth right around the trunk.
