

Cooke Named GOP Chief for 17th District

A long time Republican precinct worker has been named Precinct Chairman of the 17th Congressional District. The appointment of Douglas A. "Doug" Cooke of Westchester to the district-wide position was announced today by Charles Soderstrom of San Pedro, district chairman. Cooke, a native of Auburn, N.Y., has resided in California since 1922 and is presently the Downey area sales representative of the Mobil Oil Co., with which he has been associated for 32 years.

AN ENLISTED man in the U.S. Army in World War II, Cooke saw action in the New Guinea and Netherlands East Indies campaigns. He has long been interested in youth work and sponsored a teen club at the Dolores Mission in East Los Angeles. A member of Saint Jerome Parish, he is affiliated with the Westchester-Loyola Associates and served as president of the Catholic Center Club in 1957. Cooke has been long active in precinct work for the GOP. He was a victory squad chairman in 1954 and 1958 and became precinct chairman of the 46th Assembly District in 1958. He was appointed to the County Central Committee in 1959 and was re-elected this year.

A FOUNDING member of the Westchester Mens Republican Club, Cooke served as its first president. He is also a member of the Nixon for President Club, the Coffee for Congress Committee and the Committee to re-elect Assemblyman Charles Chapel.

Navy Veteran Gets New Post At Douglas

A 24-year Navy veteran with an extensive background in aircraft production and aeronautical research and development, Captain E. A. Lohmann has assumed his new post as Bureau of Naval Weapons representative at the Douglas Aircraft Co.'s El Segundo Division. The new El Segundo Bu-Weps-Rep, a resident of Palos Verdes, relieves Captain R. M. Gibbons, another Palos Verdes resident, who retired from Naval service last month. Prior to joining Douglas, Capt. Lohmann was acting Bureau of Naval Weapons general representative. He was assigned to that office in 1959, following a two-year tour as head of the maintenance engineering branch in the Bureau of Naval Weapons. In this capacity he was in charge of maintenance engineering for all Naval aircraft. Capt. Lohmann has long been familiar with Douglas aircraft. The association began with his first assignment as a Naval aviator to Fleet Dive-Bombing Squadron (VB-5), which was equipped with BT-1 airplanes. This was upon completion of his flight training in the spring of 1938, at Pensacola, Fla. He also flew the famed SBD Dauntless.






