Cryogenic Testing Facility in Operation Says AiResearch Co.

The Garrett Corporation's AiResearch Manufacturing Co. of Los Angeles today announced that since May, 1958 it has been operating a remote cryogenic test facility which was designed and constructed under an Air Force contract.

Located in a relatively uninhabited area near Boron, Calif., the test facility is unique in that it provides full scale component testing with liquid hydrogen.

THE CRYOGENIC test facility, built in 1957, is capable of evaluating liquid hydrogen pumps and heat exchangers. In addition, the facility is considered a valuable tool for performance and reliability testing of complete systems and associated components utilizing liquid hydrogen as the test fluid.

For example, AiResearch has used the facility to test integrated cooling and power systems for space orbital vehicles. In these systems hydrogen is used as both a fuel and a cooling agent.

The AiResearch test site is composed of three sections — a test area, control area and lab assembly building.

THE LABORATORY assembly building, constructed near the entrance of the test site is used for temporary housing of equipment, repair work, and as headquarters for security guards. For the safety of personnel this building is located 1000 feet from where the liquid hydrogen testing is performed.

The control room is located in the center of the site, 400 feet from the storage and test

area. Adequate safety for the control room is maintained through the use of reinforced concrete construction. During a test run all required operations of units in the test area are conducted remotely from the control room.

IN THE TEST area, two 6000 gallon liquid hydrogen storage tanks or conveniently placed between two test cells within reinforced concrete walls.

In the test area there is equipment available for component testing which is particularly adaptable to heat transfer, valve and rotating equipment testing.

Equipment is available to test heat exchangers using either liquid or gaseous hydrogen as the primary fluid and hot air or hot oil as a secondary fluid.


