Among her prizes are a \$6000 college scholarship, which she will use for a five-year course of study to get her credentials for teaching mentally retarded children.

On her arrival in Los Angeles Miss Sullivan was whisked from the airport to City Hall, where she was welcomed by an official proclamation in City Council meeting. The proclamation, read by Council President John S. Gibson Jr., urged that all young women of the Los Angeles area participate in such a "worthy endeavor" as the pageant.

Any high school senior girl is eligible to enter the pageant, through her city's Junior Chamber of Commerce. Judging is held in Mobile, Ala., and emphasis is placed on character, citizenship, leadership.
