

ECC Band to Give Concert On Saturday

Having worked on an extra-curricular schedule for the past several weeks, the Warrior Band of El Camino College will present a special "Opening of School" concert in the Campus Theater Saturday evening at 8:30 p.m.

The band will play under the baton of Instructor Calvin Greer.

The symphonic program will include the Bach's "Prelude Fugue in B flat," Schumann's "Variations on a Folk Song," and the "Antiphony for Winds" by Kechley.

Von Weber's "Concertino for Clarinet" will feature Wesley Brown of Gardena as soloist, while Ted Bluechel of Torrance will be featured as tympani soloist in Schinthen's "Tymponero."

Also on the musical program will be a Latin favorite by Jose Padilla, "El Relicario." Two trumpet features will be Jacoby's "Carnival Variations" and the Harry James favorite, "Trumpet Rhapsody." The latter number will feature Glen Keohane of Redondo, as soloist, with trumpeters Roger Hamilton of Hawthorne, John Spilka of Inglewood and Pete Fraley of Gardena, featured in the Jacoby number.

Other favorites on the program will be "Band of America March" by Paul Lavalle, "The Ides of March" by Donald I. Moore, and highlights from forthcoming football jazz-style shows.


