

BEHIND THE SCENES

**Business Firms More Attentive
To Health of Top Executives**

American business is paying
increasing attention to check-
ing up on the health of its sen-
ior executives.

The idea of the annual check-
up isn't new — but what is
noteworthy now is the spring-
ing up of medical organiza-
tions actually specializing in
this unusual field.

In this city, one such organiza-
tion is equipped to give full-
fledged medical examinations
in a two-hour period that in-
cludes a coffee break; the price
tag can run as high as \$125.
Testing isn't restricted to such
traditional subjects as blood
pressure and chest X-rays.
Electrocardiograms study the
heart; cancer checks are made.
At the conclusion, the physi-
cian discusses his findings with
the executive, and advises on
such subjects as whether to
gain or lose weight (often it's
the latter.)

SIMILAR clinical groups
specializing in the "super-
check-up" are found in Chi-
cago and several other cities.
Clients include the nation's
largest steel company and its
second-largest auto maker,
notes Sales Management.

While many top firms are
turning to this method, it ap-
pears that a large number will
stick to the older system of
having their own company-paid
doctor give annual check-ups
as a service of the medical de-
partment. A giant food com-
pany has had this system for
some 25 years; lower-salaried

managers and clerks get a
fairly simple check-up, while
upper-bracket officials receive
a series of tests lasting almost
a full day.

ULTIMATE AIRPLANE — A
chemically power eight-engine
aircraft capable of orbiting
the globe at speeds of up
to 17,000 miles an hour is en-
visioned by Alexander Kart-
veli, pioneer aircraft engineer
and vice president of research
and development, Republic
Aviation Corporation.

Kartveli, who is responsible
for more than 14 aircraft types
including the World War II
P-47 Thunderbolt and today's
F-105 Thunderchief, also fore-
sees at least four more "gener-
ations" of advanced aircraft
types before the building of
satellites and spaceships be-
comes the chief concern of air
vehicle makers, and aviation
gives way to "astronautics."

The Russian-born designer
says the apparent "abdication"
on the part of designers with
respect to new, unique and ad-
vanced types of aircraft design
"could cause a tragic situation
in the future." He added that
the aircraft type he believes
will be the final design to be
accomplished before the limit
of aeronautical design has been
reached is a "lifting machine
with chemical-air-breathing
power plant, carrying substan-
tial military load, capable of
taking off from the ground,
accelerating to orbital speed,
orbiting around the earth and

landing on earth when desired."

GAS ECONOMICS — The
phenomenal growth of Ameri-
can industry in the past decade
may not seem to have had a
bearing on the price of gas for
cooking, but the Gas Appliance
Manufacturers Association as-
serts there is a very close con-
nection between the two.

The gas industry, says GAMA,
has invested more than a bil-
lion dollars a year since 1945
in extending its fuel lines to
all major markets. One of the
things that has made this ex-
penditure possible is the fact
that hundreds of industries
producing consumer goods
have found 28,000 ways of us-
ing gas for processing every-
thing from automobiles to tex-
tiles and from cosmetics to
metals.

GAMA SAYS the mass in-
dustrial users of natural gas
have helped substantially to
"pay the freight" for transport-
ing the fuel on an economical
basis to the more than 34,000-
000 homes that now use it for
heating, air conditioning, cook-
ing, water heating, refrigerat-
ing, clothes drying and waste
disposal.

In many less fortunate coun-
tries, GAMA said, an efficient,
economical household fuel
would be a great boon but
there is not enough industrial
patronage to warrant the huge
investment involved in discov-
ering, producing, transmitting
and distributing it.


