Torrance Keeps Ranking Among County Cities

Torrance maintained its eighth place ranking in assessed valuation among Los Angeles County cities, the Torrance Chamber of Commerce announced yesterday.


Changes in the "top ten" positions were the drop of Burbank from third to fourth position (being replaced by Pasadena), El Segundo's disappearance from the select list, and the newly incorporated City of Commerce ranking in tenth position.

Torrance's assessed valuation jumped \$20,514,000 the report shows, bringing the City to a new high of \$215,100,000.

Los Angeles continues to lead cities in the County, followed by Long Beach, Pasadena, Burbank, Vernon, Glendale, Santa Monica, Torrance, Beverly Hills, and Commerce. El Segundo is in twelfth position with \$133,081,000 and Inglewood 14th with \$120,726,000.

Assessed valuation of other cities in this area include Redondo Beach, \$98,813,800; Hawthorne, \$81,516,000; Gardena, \$52,522,000; Manhattan Beach, \$41,391,000; Palos Verdes Estates, \$26,316,000; Hermosa Beach, \$26,026,000; Rolling Hills Estates, \$8,168,000; and Rolling Hills, \$7,564,000.






