
Dr. Beauchemin has selected a stimulating and instructive subject which should interest all physicians. The subject for the evening is "Forensic Medicine."

**American S & L Maintains 4 1/2% Interest Rate**

In a special session called to review its unprecedented rise in assets, directors of American Savings and Loan Assn. at company headquarters, Whittier, unanimously voted to continue the present 4 1/2 per cent interest rate on savings for the fourth quarter, ending Dec. 31, 1960.

This announcement was made by American Savings executive vice president, William Balopole. He added that third quarter interest payments to the association's 91,483 customers will total \$2,028,386 and that assets have soared to a new peak: \$242 million.

American Savings and Loan Assn. has 12 offices including Hawthorne, Manhattan Beach, Redondo Beach, and Redondo-South Bay.

**Douglas Gets New Skyhawk Plane Order**

The Navy has awarded a \$71,500,000 contract to the Douglas Aircraft Company, El Segundo, for further production of A4D-2N Skyhawk. It was announced today.

It is the fourth contract awarded to Douglas for this improved version of the Navy's lightest attack aircraft. Previous contracts have amounted to approximately \$232,000,000.

The A4D-2N is capable of carrying atomic weapons, rockets, guided missiles, and machine guns. It is powered by a Wright J-65 Sapphire Turbojet engine. Its speed is in excess of 650 miles per hour, range is well over 1000 nautical miles.

Navy and Marine Aviation units operate the Skyhawks from the largest and smallest carriers.
